The workshop focused on strengthening internal quality assurance mechanisms, improving coordination across units, and aligning institutional practices with national and international standards.

This initiative marks a shift towards embedding quality assurance at the core of institutional leadership, while complementing efforts under the Tanzania internationalisation strategies for higher Education (TANZIE) project, an Erasmus+ capacity-building initiative, to enhance institutional capacity, governance, and readiness for global academic engagement.

Building on this momentum, Mzumbe University will host a Training on Quality Assurance Systems and Practices in Higher Education Institutions from 13th–17th April 2026 in Morogoro.
