## 1.0 SOPAM POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

### 1.1 Overview of SOPAM PhD and Master Programmes

## 2.0 SOPAM UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

### 2.1 Overview of Bachelor Programmes

In the current globalized epoch, successful organizations emphasize on proper Human Resource Management. The SOPAM programmes prepare students for this purpose. The programmes have been reviewed in 2018 and approved by TCU. The aim of reviewing these programmes is in line with the standard of practice at Mzumbe University and, it is an attempt by the School of Public Administration and Management (SOPAM) to continuously improve its programmes.

The programmes produce specialists who establish and advance organizational policies and guidelines, and consequently utilize the tools and techniques for developing transformational work environments in both the public and private sectors. The SOPAM programmes prepare graduates to become influential corporate leaders equipped with the ability to identify, analyze, and address complex human resource and management issues.

The ongoing austerity economic measures and reforms globally and the fifth phase of Tanzania's Government require result-based human resources. The programmes are therefore designed on the premise that competent people are produced to work as middle and senior-level managers both in the private and public sectors to realize the industrialization policy. The programmes are thus designed to enable skill and knowledge acquisition to work in the public sector and the rapidly expanding private and CSO sectors.

### 2.2. General Minimum Entry Requirements

The admission to Bachelor programmes follows the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) guidelines and the regulations for Undergraduate Degree Programmes of Mzumbe University.
